## BREXIT: Checklist for EU and UK transports



As the uncertainty around Brexit continues, we provide certainty for your transports as your reliable partner. When the United Kingdom (UK) leaves the European Union (EU), every consignment to and from the UK will be subject to customs declarations. A 'No-Deal Brexit' could potentially occur at 23:00 GMT on Thursday 31st October 2019. Please stay informed about further developments in the media.

To manage your customs declarations after Brexit, we require the following information from you.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>EXPORT DECLARATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the shipper creates the export declaration independently, provide the MRN number of the export declaration (EAD) – to be inserted in the transport order – and handover the export accompanying document to the driver</li> </ul>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>INVOICE NUMBER AND CURRENCY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Included on the commercial invoice</li> <li>Electronic copy of invoice provided to Kuehne + Nagel</li> </ul>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>CUSTOMS TARIFF NUMBER (HS CODE) OF THE GOODS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Harmonised classification code of the goods</li> </ul>	<a href="#">List of Customs Tariff Number of Goods and HS Codes</a>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>DESCRIPTION OF GOODS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Precise description of the goods</li> </ul>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>VALUE OF GOODS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Value of goods and currency to calculate the customs duties and value added tax</li> </ul>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>INCOTERMS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agree on Incoterms with your business partners, as they define who is responsible for the customs clearance and associated costs</li> </ul>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>RECOMMENDED: TSP NUMBER</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Only for imports from the EU to UK</b></li> <li>UK recipient needs to register for the Transitional Simplified Procedure (TSP) only once</li> <li>TSP registration number needs to be included in the shipment information</li> </ul>	<a href="#">UK recipients can register for TSP here</a>
